3) To discuss on the applications/suggestions received from the public.

3 (1): Application from Shri. Dhananjay Pednekar.

Res. No. 3 (1):- Application dated 17/07/2018 received from Mr. Dhananjay Pednekar r/o Olaulim, regd.

Q. No.1: I want to know who are the members & the names of the members of Pomburpa Village Watch.

Ans: The Sarpanch informed that the V.P. does not have any record from Village Watch. Not satisfied with the answer the applicant i.e. Shri. Dhananjay requested the Sarpanch to obtain the same. After some discussion the Sarpanch promised to do the needful.

Q. No. 2: As per the complaint dated 23rd March'18 of the Pomburpa Village Watch Committee what action has been taken.

Ans: Inspection was carried out by V.P. & forwarded to T.C.P. Mapusa for action.

3 (2): Application from Merlyn P. Subawalla.

Res. No. 3 (2):- Application dated 16/07/2018 received from Mrs. Merlyn P. Subawalla, r/o H.No. 24/8, Olaulim.

Quest: Street light from Olaulim, specially from cross road near Damian D'costa shop to Muddi are not working.

Ans: At present the street light in W.N.I. is working.

Quest: Gutters at various places in Olaulim area are collapsed. These gutters need urgent attention & repairs before any mishap happens.

Ans: The Sarpanch informed the Gram Sabha members that necessary res. will be adopted in the fortnightly meeting. Also Sarpanch informed that no time frame can be given.

3 (3): Application from Shri. Alvito Da Silva.

Res. No. 3 (3):- Application received from Shri. Alvito J.A. D'silva, r/o H.No. 11/7, Voll, Pomburpa regarding elected representatives should conduct house to house survey & collect data of migrants staying in Pomburpa.

Further Tenants verification with the help of Health Authorities since many of the dwelling houses where these migrants are staying are not provided with proper sanitation facilities.

Communication to be sent to Police authorities to give copies of tenant verification forms of all the migrants staying in the jurisdiction. After brief discussion it is decided to request the Aldona Police Outpost to attend the next Gram Sabha meeting to report progress made on tenant verification.

3 (4): Application from Mr. Emidio Felix Da Silva.

Res. No. 3 (4):- Application received from Mr. Emidio Felix Da Silva r/o Ecoxim regd. Speed Breakers has been read out, discussed for decision. After detail discussion it is decided by the Gram Sabha members to sent reminder to concern dept. informed them that major accidents has taken place at this particular spots.

Further decided & resolved by the Gram Sabha members to write letter to Police Traffic cell, Mapusa to erect speed limit boards from Olaulim to Ecoxim since it is residential area with 30 speed limit per hour.

3 (5): Application from Shri. Amar Hadfadkar.

Res. No. 3 (5):- Application received from Amar Hadfadkar r/o Golna regd.

Quest: The preparation of bricks at Golna is legal or illegal and what tax is paying to the Panchayat.

Ans: The Sarpanch informed that this V.P. has issued temporary license in the year 2012 & imposed professional fess of Rs. 500/- per year. Shri. Nilesh spoke & agreed to promise to pay Rs. 5000/- per year.

Quest: Open Air Hall at Arao Dos Equis is the hall owner paying the taxes? And what is the amount of taxes? The Sarpanch informed that Rs. 3500/- per year & from April'18 this V.P. has increased 10%. Further Shri. Nelson Da Silva spoke & promised to pay 7000/-. After detail discussion the Sarpanch informed that the matter & necessary resolution will adopt in the Fortnightly meeting.

3 (6): Application from Mr. Vinay V. Chopdekar.

Res. No. 3 (6):- Application received from Mr. Vinay V. Chopdekar, r/o Golna regd.

Quest: Shri. Naresh Datta Shirodkar was considered in the Social Economic Survey.

Ans: The Sarpanch promised to look into the matter.

Quest: The proposal was pending with D.O.P. for up-gradation of website.

Ans: Sarpanch informed to take up the matter.

After detail discussion it was decided & resolved by the Gram Sabha members to request the Director, D.O.P. Panaji to grant administrative approval for utilizing fund from XIIIth F.C. Grants, available with V.P. for upkeep & maintenance of V.P. website.

3 (7): Application from Mr. Vinay V. Chopdekar.

Res. No. 3 (7):- Application dated 16/07/2018 received from Mr. Vinay V. Chopdekar r/o Golna regd. repairs of the Hindu Crematorium at Golna has been read out, discussed for decision. The Sarpanch V.P. informed that vide letter No. DRDA-N/EW/GGSY/2015-16/2573 dated 18/02/2016 received from Ex. Engineer, DRDA, North Panaji regd. proposal approved by the G.G.S.Y. Committee. Further the N.O.C's for water & electric connection are in the file the said informed.

After some discussion Shri. Vinay Chopdekar ex. Sarpanch informed that this V.P. has forwarded resolution to P.W.D. Mapusa to take up the repairs of compound wall of Hindu Crematorium.

3 (8): Appointment of Swachhagrahis.

Res. No. 3 (8):- The V.P. Secretary read out the Memorandum No. 3-EOVP-I/BDO-BAR/Mem/2018-19/4472 dated 03/07/2018 received from BDO-I, Bardez regd. appointment of "Swachhagrahis" for every Village in the Gram P. in the state of Goa has been discussed for decision. After prolong discussion none of Gram Sabha members has given their names for Swachhagrahis.

3 (9): Construction of retaining wall in W.No. I.

Res. No. 3 (9):- It is decided & resolved by the Gram Sabha members to request Director, D.O.P. Panaji through BDO-I Bardez to undertake the work of const. of retaining wall near house of Elvis Pinto in W.N. I Olaulim village under XIVth Finance Commission Grants.

Resolution passed unanimously.

3 (10): De-silting & repair of existing wall in W.No. 6.

Res. No. 3 (10):- It is hereby resolved to request Director, D.O.P. Panaji through B.D.O. Bardez to depute EORE to conduct site inspection & prepare estimate for the work of de-silting & repair of existing wall near Mahesh Poi house near Kudneshwar Temple near G.P.S. near Jayprakash Halarnkar house W.No. 6 at Ecoxim in V.P. Pomburpa-Olaulim under XIVth Finance Commission Grants.

3 (11): Construction of gutter in W.N. II.

Res. No. 3 (11):- It is decided to request Director, D.O.P. Panaji through B.D.O. Bardez to grant approval for the work of const. of gutter from Domnic Fernandes house to nullah near Mendes house in W.N. II in V.P. jurisdiction under XIVth Finance Commission Grants.

3 (12): Re-construction of existing D/W wells in W.No. III.

Res. No. 3 (12):- It is decided & resolved by the Gram Sabha members to request Director, D.O.P. Panaji through B.D.O. Bardez to undertake the work of re-const. of existing D/W wells near Anil Haldankar house at Golna in W.No. III in V.P. Pomburpa-Olaulim under XIVth Finance Commission Grants.

The above works already sent to B.D.O. Bardez for approval.

3 (13):

Res. No. 3 (13):- It is hereby decided & resolved by the Gram Sabha members to purchase xerox machine with printer cum scanner with tonner, legal size for the purpose of office use only under XIVth F.C. Grants by following all the procedure.

3 (14):

Res. No. 3 (14):- It is brought to the notice by the Chairperson to the Gram Sabha members that since reasonable infrastructure was not available for storing records of this V.P., old records were stored on loft. These records were consisting of various files, certificates, registers, etc.

As you can observe, there is dampness due to water seepage & other climate conditions. This provides good conditions for white ants/termites, etc. During one of the inspection, it is noticed that records has been totally destroyed by white ants. After noticing this immediately anti termites treatment was undertaken to prevent further damage.

This matter has been brought before Gram Sabha meeting for the information of the Gram Sabha members.
